1. General

This document describes the tournament format of the U10 Category at "HaBaWaBa International Festival 2023".

- Eligible to participate are boys and girls born in 2013 and later
- Participation: 37 teams
- Grouping: 3 Groups (G2, G3 and G4) of 9 teams and 1 Group (G1) of 10 teams.
- Competition dates: 6 days
- Competition fields: 2

2. Format U10 Category

The competition format of the HaBaWaBa U10 Category consists of two Phases A and B as described below:

2.1 PHASE A

In this phase, all teams play against the teams within their Group in a Round Robin system, that is, every team meets up with the other teams in their own group.

Total Number of Matches in Phase A= 153

2.2 PHASE B

2.2.1 Gold Tournament

2.2.1.1 Gold Tournament - Quarter Finals

At the end of Phase, A, the 1st and 2nd teams per group, will play in the Quarter-Finals of the Gold Tournament (8 participants) as per the competition tree below.



- 1G1 – 2G4 (Match P1)
- 2G2 – 1G3 (Match P2)
- 1G2 – 2G3 (Match P3)
- 2G1 – 1G4 (Match P4)

2.2.1.2 Gold Tournament - Semi Finals

The winners of the Quarter-Finals phase proceed to the Gold Tournament Semi-Finals (4 teams).

- Winner P1 – Winner P2 (Match P5)
- Winner P3 – Winner P4 (Match P6)

2.2.1.3 Gold Tournament - Finals

- Winner P5 – Winner P6 (Match P7)

Number of Matches =7

2.2.2 Silver Tournament

2.2.2.1 Silver Tournament - Quarter Finals

At the end of Phase, A, the 3rd and 4th teams per group, will play in the Quarter-Finals of the Silver Tournament (8 participants) as per the competition tree below.



- 3G1 – 4G4 (Match S1)
- 4G2 – 3G3 (Match S2)
- 3G2 – 4G3 (Match S3)
- 4G1 – 3G4 (Match S4)

2.2.2.2 Silver Tournament - Semi Finals

The winners of the Quarter-Finals phase proceed to the Silver Tournament Semi-Finals (4 teams).

- Winner S1 – Winner S2 (Match S5)
- Winner S3 – Winner S4 (Match S6)

2.2.2.3 Silver Tournament - Finals

- Winner S5 – Winner P6 (Match S7)

Number of Matches =7

2.2.3 Bronze Tournament

2.2.3.1 Bronze Tournament - Quarter Finals

At the end of Phase, A, the 5th and 6th teams per group, will play in the Quarter-Finals of the Bronze Tournament (8 participants) as per the competition tree below.



- 5G1 – 6G4 (Match B1)
- 6G2 – 5G3 (Match B2)
- 5G2 – 6G3 (Match B3)
- 6G1 – 5G4 (Match B4)

2.2.3.2 Bronze Tournament - Semi Finals

The winners of the Quarter-Finals phase proceed to the Bronze Tournament Semi-Finals (4 teams).

- Winner B1 – Winner P2 (Match B5)
- Winner B3 – Winner P4 (Match B6)

2.2.3.3 Bronze Tournament - Finals

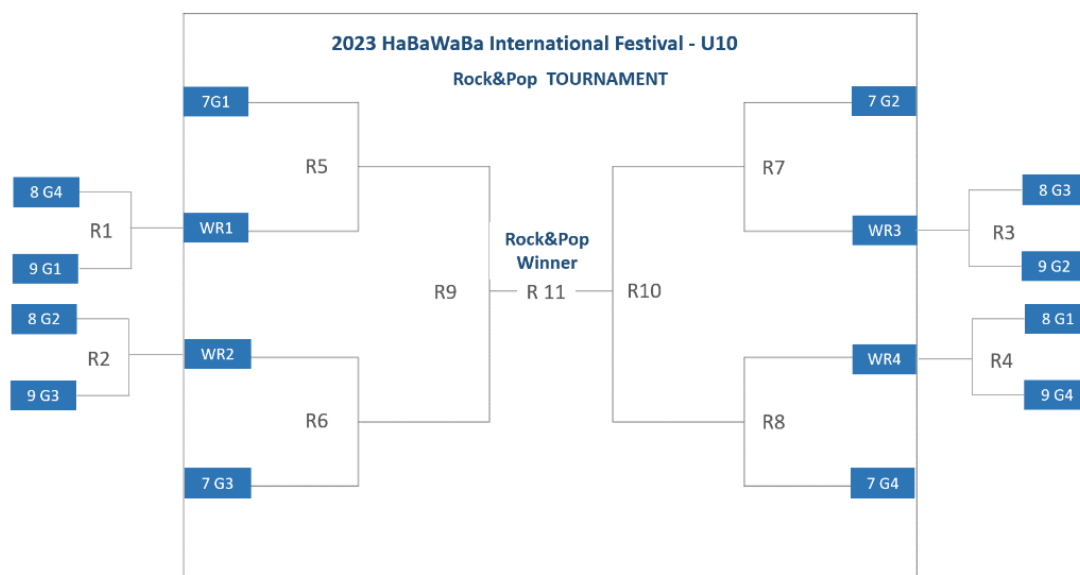
- Winner B5 – Winner P6 (Match B7)

2.2.4 Rock&Pop Tournament

2.2.4.1 Rock&Pop Tournament - 8 Finals

At the end of Phase, A, the teams from the 8th to 9th or 10th place per group, will play in the 8-Finals of the Rock&Pop Tournament (8 participants) as per the competition tree below. At first the teams ranked 9th and 10th in the Group G1 will play a single game to decide which team will proceed to play against the team 8th G4. The teams ranked 7th will wait the winners of the 8-Finals.



- 9G1-10G1 (March RX)
- 8G4 – winner match RX (Match R1)
- 8G2 – 9G3 (Match R2)
- 8G3 – 9G2 (Match R3)
- 8G1 – 9G4 (Match R4)

2.2.4.2 Rock&Pop Tournament - Quarter Finals

- Winner R1 – 7G1 (Match R5)
- Winner R2 – 7G3 (Match R6)
- Winner R3 – 7G2 (Match R7)
- Winner R4 – 7G4 (Match R8)

2.2.4.3 Rock&Pop Tournament - Semi Finals

- Winner R5 – Winner R6 (Match R9)
- Winner R7 – Winner R8 (Match R10)

2.2.4.4 Rock&Pop Tournament - Final

- Winner R9 – Winner R10 (Match R11)
