1. General

This document describes the tournament format of the U13 Category at HaBaWaBa Plus 2023".

- Eligible to participate are boys and girls born in 2010 and later
- Participation: Up to 36 teams
- Grouping: 4 Groups of up to 9 teams (Group A, Group B, Group C, Group D) - depending on the final participation some groups might consist of 8 teams.
- Competition dates: 6 days
- Competition fields: 4

2. Format HaBaWaBa Plus - U13 Category

The competition format of the HaBaWaBa Plus - U13 Category consists of two Phases; A and B as described below:

2.1 PHASE A

During phase A, all teams per Group A, Group B, Group C, Group D will play against each other in Round-Robin tournaments, so each team will play up to 8 games within their own Group.

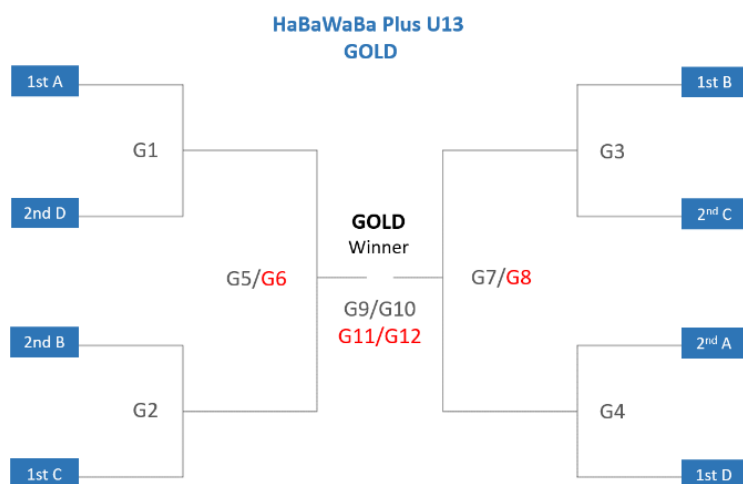
Total number of matches in Phase A = 144

2.2 PHASE B

2.2.1 Gold Tournament

2.2.1.1 Gold Tournament - Quarter-Finals

At the end of Phase A, the teams classified 1st and 2nd in the Groups A, B, C and D move forward to the HaBaWaBa Plus U13 Gold Tournament (8 participants) as per the following competition tree.



- 1st Group A – 2nd Group D (Match G1)
- 2nd Group B - 1st Group C (Match G2)
- 1st Group B - 2nd Group C (Match G3)
- 2nd Group A - 1st Group D (Match G4)

2.2.1.2 Gold Tournament - Semi Finals

- Winner Match G1 – Winner Match G2 (Match G5) - Positions 1-4

- Loser Match G1 – Loser Match G2 (Match G6) - Positions 5-8
- Winner Match G3 – Winner Match G4 (Match G7) - Positions 1-4
- Loser Match G3 – Loser Match G4 (Match G8) - Positions 5-8

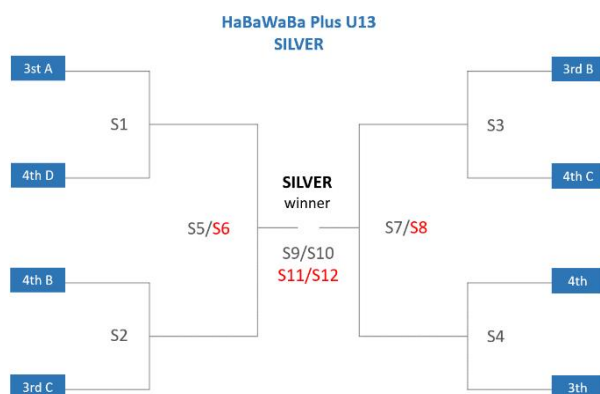
2.2.1.3 Gold Tournament - Finals

- Winner Match G5 - Winner Match G7 (Match G12) - Positions 1-2
- Loser Match G5 – Loser Match G7 (Match G11) - Positions 3-4
- Winner Match G5 - Winner Match G6 (Match G10) - Positions 5-6
- Loser Match G5 – Loser Match G6 (Match G09) - Positions 7-8

Total Number of Matches in Gold Tournament=12

2.2.2 Silver Tournament

At the end of Phase, A, the 3rd and 4th teams in each group according to their ranking proceed to the HaBaWaBa Plus U13 Silver tournament (8 participants).



2.2.2.1 Silver Tournament - Quarter Finals

- 3rd Group A - 4th Group D (Match S1)
- 4th Group B - 3rd Group C (Match S2)
- 3rd Group B - 4th Group C (Match S3)
- 4th Group A - 3rd Group D (Match S4)

2.2.2.2 Silver Tournament - Semi Finals

- Winner Match S1 – Winner Match S2 (Match S5) - Positions 9-12
- Loser Match S1 – Loser Match S2 (Match S6) - Positions 13-16
- Winner Match S3 - Winner Match S4 (Match S7) - Positions 9-12
- Loser Match S3 – Loser Match S4 (Match S8) - Positions 13-16

2.2.2.3 Silver Tournament - Final

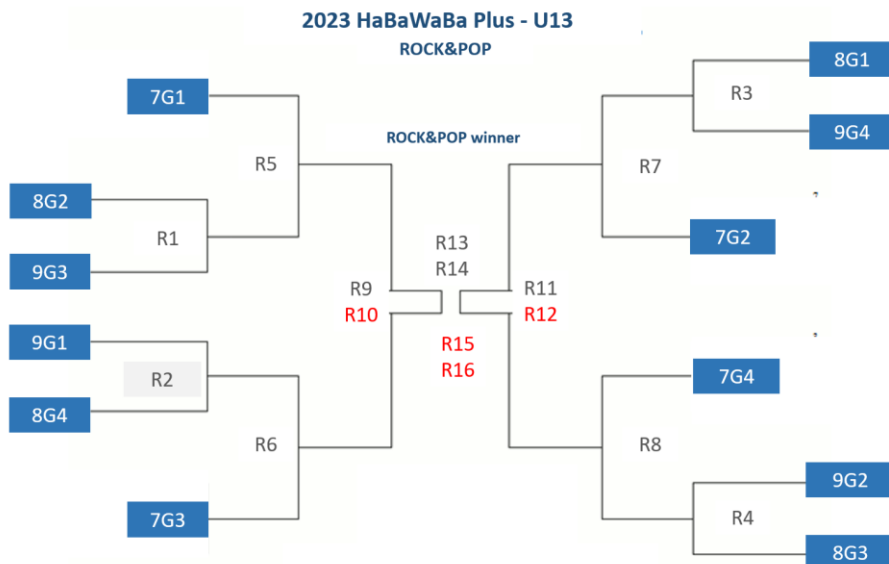
- Winner Match S5 – Winner Match S7 (Match S9) - Positions 9-10
- Loser Match S5 – Loser Match S7 (Match S10) - Position 11-12
- Winner Match S5 – Winner Match S6 (Match S10) - Positions 13-14
- Loser Match S5 – Loser Match S6 (Match S9) - Position 15-16

Total Number of Matches in Silver Tournament=12

Total Number of Matches in Bronze Tournament=12

2.2.4 Rock&Pop Tournament

At the end of Phase, A, the teams ranked 7th, 8th, 9th move forward to the Rock&Pop tournament (12 participants) as per the competition tree below.



2.2.4.1 Rock&Pop Tournament - Eight Finals

- 08G2 – 09G3 (Match R1)
- 09G1 – 08G4 (Match R2)
- 08G1 – 09G4 (Match R3)
- 09G2 – 08G3 (Match R4)

Number of Matches = 4

2.2.4.2 Rock&Pop Tournament - Quarter Finals

Positions 1 to 8

- Winner Match R1 – 7G1 (Match R5)
- Winner Match R2 – 7G3 (Match R6)
- Winner Match R3 – 7G2 (Match R7)
- Winner Match R4 – 7G4 (Match R8)

Positions 9-12

- Loser Match R1 - Loser Match R2 (Match X1)
- Loser Match R3 - Loser Match R4 (Match X2)

Number of Matches = 6

2.2.4.3 Rock&Pop Tournament - Semi Finals

Positions 1 to 4 – 5 to 8

- Winner Match R5 - Winner Match R6 (Match R9)
- Loser Match R5 – Loser Match R6 (Match R10)
- Winner Match R7 - Winner Match R8 (Match R11)
- Loser Match R7 - Loser Match R8 (Match R12)

Positions 9 -10, 11-12

- Winner Match X1 - Winner Match X2 (Match X3) positions 9-10
- Loser Match X1 – Loser Match X2 (Match X4) positions 11-12

Number of Matches = 6

2.2.4.4 Rock&Pop Tournament Finals

Positions 1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8

- Winner Match R9 - Winner Match R10 (Match R13) positions 1-2
- Loser Match R9 – Loser Match R10 (Match R14) positions 3-4
- Winner Match R10 - Winner Match R12 (Match R15) positions 5-6
- Loser Match R10 - Loser Match R12 (Match R16) positions 7-8

Number of Matches = 4

Total Number of Matches in Bronze Tournament=12

Total Number of Matches = 144 + 12 + 12 + 12 + 20 = 200
