

HABAWABA INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL PLUS 2025

U13 WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT FORMAT

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1. General

This document describes the tournament format of the U13 women's category of "HaBaWaBa International Festival PLUS 2025".

- In the U13 female category, girls born in 2012 are eligible to participate.
- Participation: up to 12 teams
- Grouping: 2 groups (G1 and G2) of maximum 6 teams. (depending on the final participation some groups could be composed of 5 teams)
- Competition days: 6
- Competition fields: 1

2. Format Category U13 female

The competition format for the U13 female category consists of three Phases; A, B and C as described below:

2.1 PHASE A

In this phase each team meets once all the other teams belonging to its group (Round-Round), so each team will play up to 5 matches within their own group.

Total number of matches in phase A = 30

2.2 PHASE B

At the end of Phase A, the 4 teams based on their ranking in groups G1, G2 will form 2 new groups of 6 teams (G1*, G2*) according to the following scheme. Once again, each team meets all the other teams belonging to its group; therefore, each team will play up to 5 matches within its group.:

G1*	G2*
1G1	1G2
2G2	2G1
3G1	3G2
4G2	4G1
5G1	5G2
6G2	6G1

Total number of matches in phase B = 30

2.3 PHASE C

2.3.1 Quarterfinals Silver & Bronze

At the end of Phase B, the teams ranked 3rd to 6th advance to the quarter-final stage for the Silver and Bronze tournaments, as follows.

- 3G*1 – 6G*2 (Match SB1)
- 3G*2 – 6G*1 (Match SB2)
- 4G*1 – 5G*2 (Match SB3)
- 5G*1 – 4G*2 (Match SB4)

Number of games = 4

2.3.2 Gold & Silver Quarterfinals

At the end of the Silver & Bronze Quarterfinals, the winning teams meet the teams ranked 1st and 2nd in face B in the Gold & Silver Quarterfinals.

- 1G*1 – SB4 winner (Match GS1)
- 1G*2 – winner SB3 (Match GS2)
- 2G*1 – winner SB2 (Match GS3)
- 2G*2 – SB1 winner (Match GS4)

Number of games = 4

2.3.3 Gold Tournament

2.3.3.1 Gold Tournament – Semifinals

The 4 winning teams from the Gold & Silver Quarterfinals proceed to the Gold Semifinals for places 1st to 4th as follows:

- Winner GS1 – Winner GS4 (Match G01)
- Winner GS2 – Winner GS3 (Match G02)

2.3.3.2 Gold Tournament - Finals

- Loser G01 – Loser G02 (Match G03) 3rd - 4th places
- Winner G01 – Winner G02 (Match G04) 1st - 2nd places

Number of games = 4

2.3.4 Silver Tournament

2.3.4.1 Silver Tournament – Semifinals

The 4 losing teams from the Gold & Silver Quarterfinals compete in the Silver Semifinals for places 5th to 8th as follows:

- Loser GS1 – Loser GS4 (Match S01)
- Loser GS2 – Loser GS3 (Match S02)

2.3.4.2 Silver Tournament - Finals

- Loser S01 – Loser S02 (Match S03) 7th – 8th places
- Winner S01 – Winner S02 (Match S04) 5th - 6th places

Number of games = 4

2.3.5 Bronze Tournament

2.3.5.1 Bronze Tournament – Semifinals

At the end of the Silver & Bronze Quarterfinals, the losing teams advance to the Bronze Semifinals for places 9th to 12th as follows:

- Loser SB1 – Loser SB4 (Match B01)
- Loser SB2 – Loser SB3 (Match B02)

2.3.5.2 Bronze Tournament – Finals

- Loser B01 – Loser B02 (Match B03) 11th-12th places
- Winner B01 – Winner B02 (Match B04) 9th - 10th° places

Number of games = 4

Total number of games = 30 + 30 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 80
